Vancouver sex workers speak out in response to passing of federal prostitution bill

Vancouver, BC [November 5, 2014]—On Thursday, November 6, a coalition of sex workers will hold a press conference to respond to Bill C-36, which received approval from the Senate yesterday after third reading. The new federal sex work legislation will come into law once it receives royal assent tomorrow.
